# RULES.

- 1—The Society shall be called the "Worthing Archæological Society."
- **2**—Its objects shall be to promote the study of Archæology in all its branches, and especially the proper recording and preservation of local antiquities, the Worthing Museum being the Headquarters of the Society.
- 3—Its affairs shall be managed by a President, Honorary Secretary, and Honorary Treasurer, in addition to a Committee of seven members which shall be elected annually. Nominations for any of the offices must be sent to the Honorary Secretary a fortnight before the date of the Annual General Meeting.
- 4—The Officers shall be a President, Vice-Presidents, Honorary Secretary, and Honorary Treasurer. The President, Honorary Secretary, and Honorary Treasurer, shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting. The Vice-Presidents shall include His Worship the Mayor of Worthing, the Deputy Mayor, the Chairman of the Library and Museum Committee.
  - 5—The Annual General Meeting shall be held in March.
- 6—Candidates for membership must be recommended by two or more members, one of whom must know the candidate personally: elections to take place at Committee Meetings.
- 7—The Annual Subscription shall be 5/-, with an Entrance Fee of 2/6. All Subscriptions become due on April 1st. Members who are two years in arrears automatically cease membership.
- 8—Members wishing to resign from membership must notify the Honorary Secretary in writing, otherwise they will be held liable for current Subscriptions.
- 9—At all ordinary Meetings and Excursions each member is permitted to introduce one visitor, who must obtain a 1/- Meeting Ticket.
- 10—An Honorary Auditor shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting.
- 11—Any alterations of the Rules must take place at a General Meeting.

# Twenty-Sixth Annual Report for the Year ending March 31st, 1948.

The Committee has pleasure in submitting the Annual Report on the work of the Society for the year 1947-48.

Membership. It is very satisfactory to be able to report that a record membership of 354 has been reached. During the year seventy-six new members were elected, nineteen resigned, six allowed their membership to lapse, and seven, including two past Presidents, died. It is with deep regret their names are recorded:—Mr. C. R. Bater, Miss E. I. Beer, Mrs. R. Bryans, Miss H. Jenkins, Mr. W. T. Smithies, Mr. L. F. A. Stuttig, and the Rev. G. D. C. Wheeler, M.A., F.Z.S., F.R.E.S. The Rev. G. D. C. Wheeler was President during the year 1929-30, and Mr. Smithies during 1936-37, both these gentlemen rendered great service to the Society not only during their Presidency but also during the years they were members of the Committee.

President, Officers, and Committee. The precedent created last year by the election of a President for a second consecutive period of office was amply justified, and Dr. A. H. Thomas has again filled that office with distinction and to the great advantage of the Society.

The Hon. Secretary, Miss E. Gerard, and the Hon. Treasurer, Miss G. L. Dean were again re-elected to those respective offices. Mr. C. T. Speed, who had been Hon. Auditor since 1941, desiring to be relieved from that office, Mr. E. M. Miller was elected in his stead.

No change has taken place on the Committee during the year.

Meetings. It has been a very successful year in the matter of meetings. The first of the summer outings was held in April when a visit was made to Preston Manor, Brighton. Mr. H. D. Roberts, M.B.E., the Hon. Curator, met the party and gave them a most interesting account of the Manor and its history, after which the members inspected the house and grounds. This was a most pleasant outing and was greatly enjoyed.

In May the Members went to Boxgrove Church, which was described by the Vicar, the Rev. A. E. Popham, afterwards they proceeded to Chichester for tea. The whole day outing in June was to Penshurst Place, special facilities for the visit having been given by Lord de Lisle and Dudley. On the outward journey a break

was made for lunch at Tunbridge Wells, and the same at East Grinstead for tea on the way home. In July Members visited Shipley Church, and the "Blue Idol," the old Quaker Meeting House near Coolham. In August they went to Alfriston, and in September to Pulborough Church, after visiting which they went on to New Place Manor, Pulborough, where they had tea, and heard from its present owner, Mr. W. B. Clifton, something of the history of that interesting old house.

The lectures in connection with the winter session, which have had record attendance, opened in the Art Gallery in October, when Dr. Thomas gave as his Presidential Address an illustrated lecture on "Art and Symbol in the Roman Catacombs and Churches." The Mayor presided upon that occasion.

An innovation in the form of a sound film, "The Beginnings of History." to which Dr. A. E. Wilson supplied the introductory remarks, was also arranged during October. This was shown in the Court Room of the Town Hall.

In November Mr. G. A. Holleyman, F.S.A., gave a most interesting lecture entitled "An Archæologist in the Hebrides," in which he traced the history from very early times of some of those comparatively little known islands where many ancient customs still survive.

In December Dr. W. E. Swinton, F.R.S.E., paid another welcome visit, this time to lecture on "Extinct Reptiles of the Sea and Air"-—a subject linking well to his former lecture last year on "The Dinosaurs."

The Annual Supper was one of the high lights of the winter session, and took place at Mitchell's Arcade Restaurant in January. The meal itself was excellent, and was followed by a "Quiz" in which two teams under the rival leadership of Dr. A. E. Wilson and Mr. G. A. Holleyman took part. Those constituting the teams were Miss G. Field, Mrs. Roper, Mr. E. E. Lawson, Alderman F. W. H. Migeod, Mr. J. H. Pull, and Mr. W. J. Roberts. The President being the Question Master. This was a thoroughly enjoyable function.

In February Mr. S. H. R. Ghey, a former President, gave a most informative paper on "How to see a Parish Church," a subject calculated to add considerable interest to future visits to Sussex Churches.

Following the Annual Business Meeting in March Dr. A. E. Wilson gave a full Report on the excavation work on Highdown Hill which was carried out under his supervision in 1947.

All the lectures were illustrated by lantern slides, the lanternist being Mr. Francis who operated with his usual skill,

Finance. The year closes with a total balance of £38 8s. £34 5s. has been spent on Excavations, and a further £5 will probably be needed to cover outstanding bills.

Excavations. During August work was continued on Highdown, following the removal of the war-time constructions, within that ancient hill fort. A new cutting confirmed the main conclusion of the excavation interrupted by the outbreak of war in 1939, and added new details about the periods and methods of fortification. Examination of the eastern entrance revealed the fact that the existing trackway through the rampart, though an old one, was not the original one, but the original ditch and the original causeway were located a little to the north. Investigation under the rampart to the north of the existing entrance revealed the main gatepost holes of the original entrance and a complicated system of recent post holes and ditches. During the work fragments of at least two smashed Saxon cinerary urns were found, and the skeleton of a six month old Saxon baby buried with a single bead.

The excavations yielded little of a spectular nature, but has made it possible to develop considerably the technical knowledge obtained from the previous investigation of Sussex hill forts.

A full report on the work will appear in a forthcoming volume of the Sussex Archæological Collection.

Co-operation. The President and the Hon. Secretary were appointed to serve on the local Committee in connection with the Conference of the S.E.U.S.S. held in Brighton in July. Mrs. Roper was appointed to act as liason officer between this Society and the Sussex Archæological Research Committee formed by the Sussex Archæological Society.

Gift of Books. A bequest of four volumes of Sussex interest was made by the late Miss J. L. R. Blaker, who died in July, 1947, to the Library of this Society.

Acknowledgments. The Committee desires publicly to record its thanks to the Library and Museum Committee of the Town Council for allowing the Winter Meetings to be held in the Art Gallery; to Mr. S. H. R. Ghey and Mr. G. A. Holleyman for their lectures; to Mr. W. J. Roberts for describing Shipley Church and the "Blue Idol"; to Dr. A. E. Wilson for undertaking and organising the work on Highdown, and to his band of enthusiastic helpers who worked so strenuously, particularly to Mr. Burstow, Mr. A. J. Clifford, and Mr. G. A. Holleyman.
