RULES.

1.—The Society shall be called the "Worthing Archæological Society."

2.—Its objects shall be to promote the study of Archæology in all its branches, and especially the proper recording and preservation of local antiquities. The Worthing Museum being the headquarters of the Society.

3.—Its affairs shall be managed by a President, Hon. Secretary, and Hon. Treasurer, in addition to a Committee of seven members which shall be elected annually. Nominations for any of the offices must be sent to the Hon. Secretary a fortnight before the date of the Annual Meeting.

4.—The Officers shall be a President, Vice-Presidents, Hon. Secretary, and Hon. Treasurer. The President, Hon. Treasurer, and Hon. Secretary to be elected at the Annual General Meeting. The Vice-Presidents shall include His Worship the Mayor of Worthing, the Deputy Mayor, the Chairman of the Museum, Library, and Art Gallery Committee, and Col. Margesson.

5.—The Annual General Meeting shall be held in March.

6.—Candidates for membership must be recommended by two or more members, one of whom must know the candidate personally: elections to take place at Committee Meetings.

7.—The annual subscription shall be 5/-, with an entrance fee of 2/6.

 $8.\mathrm{--At}$  all ordinary Meetings and Excursions each member is permitted to introduce one visitor, who must obtain a 1/- Meeting Ticket.

9.—An Hon. Auditor shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting.

10.—Any alteration of the Rules must take place at a General Meeting.

# The NINTH ANNUAL REPORT of the Worthing Archæological Society, presented March 16th, 1931.

The Committee has pleasure in reporting another year of successful work.

Membership. The present membership of the Society is 304, the highest number yet reached, forty-nine of whom have been elected during the year. Eighteen members have resigned, five have died, and two have allowed their membership to lapse. Allowing for these losses, the membership shows a total increase of twenty-four on previous figures.

The Committee regrets to record the death of the following members:—Mrs. Bennett, Mrs. F. Port, Miss M. J. Lockie, Alderman E. Dixon, Mr. C. W. Barnes.

President, Officers and Committee. The Society is to be congratulated in having had as its President this year, Sir Arthur Smith-Woodward, F.R.S., the eminent palæontologist. The officers were re-elected without change at the beginning of the session, and the seats vacated on the Committee by Alderman A. Nichols and Mr. A. D. Mackenzie were filled by the election of the Rev. G. D. C. Wheeler, M.A., F.Z.S., F.E.S., and the Rev. C. G. Ledger, M.A.

Summer Session. The Summer Session commenced with a meeting at Cissbury on April 12th, arranged for the purpose of inspecting the excavations then being carried on there under the supervision of Dr. E. C. Curwen and Mr. Ross Williamson. Nearly a hundred members attended and were joined by others from the Sussex Archæological Society, the Brighton and Hove Archæological Club, and the Littlehampton Nature and Archæology Circle. Despite exceedingly inclement weather the greatest interest was shown both in Dr. Curwen's account of the work and in the excavations. The following month a visit was paid to the churches at Kirdford and Billingshurst, and in the latter village an interesting old malt house, now converted into tea rooms, was inspected. The annual all-day Excursion in June, was, at the request of a number of members, made to Hurstmonceux, where both the Castle and church were visited. In July the churches at Cuckfield and Bolney were visited, and in August a further opportunity of inspecting excavation work while in progress was afforded members by a

meeting held at the Trundle, where Dr. E. C. Curwen met the party and described to them the work he was then engaged upon. The last meeting of the summer was to Hangleton, where, through the kindness of Lady Erroll the Manor house was inspected under the guidance of Mr. Frederick Harrison, after which a visit was also paid to the church. With the exception of the Cissbury meeting fine weather attended all the summer meetings and added considerably to their success.

Winter Session. The meetings of the winter session have been held, as usual, in the Art Gallery, and have been of exceptional interest. The first was a Lantern Lecture, and was given in October to a crowded audience, by the President, Sir Arthur Smith-Woodward, who dealt with "The Animals associated with Palaeolithic Man in Sussex." The following month Dr. E. C. Curwen lectured on the work carried out at Cissbury earlier in the year. In December, Mr. H. S. Toms, Curator of the Brighton Museum, gave 'A Folklore Chat on Witchstones and Shepherds' Crowns," and in January the Rev. W. J. Pressey, M.A., F.S.A., gave "A Talk about Church Plate." The last Lecture of the session, which was one of the most popular, was given in February, by Dr. R. E. Mortimer Wheeler, M.C., M.A., F.S.A., who lectured on recent excavation work connected with "The Earliest Capitals of Britain," and in the course of it paid a tribute to the importance of the work carried out by the President at Piltdown, which had resulted in giving Sussex a place in the history of mankind unsurpassed by any other locality.

Excavations. During the year most successful excavation work has been achieved at Cissbury under the very thorough and able supervision of Dr. E. C. Curwen and Mr. Ross Williamson. A Report of the work has been prepared by Dr. Curwen, and has been printed and circulated to all members of the Society.

British Association Meeting. The Society was represented, as a Corresponding Society, by the Hon. Secretary at the British Association Meeting, held at Bristol in September.

Disfigurement of the Downs. Protests on behalf of the Society were made in the autumn, against the unsightly chalk letters which were placed upon the S.W. slope of the Downs, below Cissbury, by a local Company, advertising the Cissbury Building Estate. It is satisfactory to report that these letters have since been removed.

Donations. The Society has had the pleasure of contributing donations to the Billingshurst Church Heating Fund, the Bolney and the Hangleton Church Restoration Funds, and to that of Keymer Windmill.

Finances. The finances of the Society are in a satisfactory condition, and show a total balance of £31 4s. 3d. The fact that this balance is lower than in former years is accounted for by the fact that the sum of £100 19s. 5d. was spent on the Cissbury excavations.

The Committee desires publicly to accord thanks to the Committee of the Worthing Public Library, Museum and Art Gallery for the continued favour of allowing the winter meetings to be held in the Art Gallery; to Dr. and Mrs. H. Milbank-Smith for kind hospitality to visiting lecturers; to Dr. E. C. Curwen and Mr. Ross Williamson for so ably supervising the excavations; to Lady Erroll for allowing members to visit Hangleton Manor House, to Mr. Frederick Harrison for acting as guide upon that occasion; to the lecturers who have so generously given their services; and to the Incumbents of the various churches visited for affording facilities for inspection.
